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Classroom Discussion Questions

1. In the video there is a line:

"It makes me feel sad."

- Do you think seeing kids getting bullied makes other students feel sad? Why?
- It's known that students who are bullied are negatively impacted, but what about those who witness it. How are they affected?
- What about those who bully? How does that behavior impact their school experience and future life?

2. In the video there is a line:

"It hurts my feelings."

- Do you think emotional bullying (such as gossip, rumors, or name calling) can be more harmful and painful than physical bullying? Why?
- Do negative words and put-downs stay with someone longer than a punch or push?
- How does negativity that happens over and over, day after day, impact how someone feels about herself? What can happen as a result?

3. In the video, there is a line:

"It's better to be a friend."

- Students who are bullied often say "I feel so alone." How does having a friend or someone who cares make a difference?
- Have you ever wanted to help someone being bullied, but didn't know what to do? What are ways
 that you can show that you care?
- What happens when someone is being bullied and no one does anything? How do you think this makes the person being bullied feel?
